



Saint-Émilion

<i>Surface area and soils</i>	7 hectares (17 acres), including the young Carillon d'Angelus vines. The plots are planted on 3 types of soils: - one made up of cold, late-ripening clay, - one made up of warmer clay, sand and limestone, - one made up of faster-draining and earlier-ripening soils
<i>Density of plantation</i>	6,500 to 8,500 vines per hectare depending on the soil characteristics
<i>Grape composition</i>	90% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon
<i>Pruning</i>	Respectful of the flow of the sap, adapted to the vigour of the grape variety and to the soil-type
<i>Harvesting</i>	Picking date according to berry sampling for optimal ripeness
<i>Vinifications</i>	In stainless steel vats. - Temperature of alcoholic fermentation up to 28°C - Post-fermentation maceration: 1 week
<i>Barrel-filling</i>	After the malo-lactic fermentation
<i>Ageing</i>	14 to 16 months, traditional Bordeaux ageing
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<i>Totale surface area</i>	85 ha (210 acres), including 55 hectares in Saint-Émilion
<i>Winemaker and Oenologist</i>	Hubert de Bouïard de Laforest
